LOW-INCOME CORPORATE TAX CREDIT SCHOLARSHIPS CRITERIA AND INCOME GUIDELINES (JULY 1, 2021 – JUNE 30, 2022)

- 1. The applicant currently is enrolled or applied with a qualified private school in the state of Arizona.
- 2. The applicant attended an Arizona public school as a full-time student for at least 90 days of the prior fiscal year and then transferred from the public school to a private school <u>OR</u> is enrolling in a private school kindergarten <u>OR</u> is enrolling in a private preschool program for students with a disability <u>OR</u> is a dependent of a member of the armed forces of the United States who is stationed in Arizona pursuant to military orders <u>OR</u> received for any year a scholarship under one of the above criteria or from the original individual donation program or the switcher individual donation program if the child continued to attend a private school in subsequent years.
- 3. The applicant has a current application process on file with TOPS for Kids. (This must be done each year, usually in the early spring.)
- 4. The applicant has a tuition balance/need at a qualified private school in the state of Arizona. (TOPS for Kids will check with the school to determine what the balance may be at the time of the award.)
- 5. The applicant's family income must be less than 185% of the Federal Free and Reduced-Priced Lunch Program Guidelines relative to their household size. Please refer to the following table for income limits by household size.
