INDIVIDUAL SCHOLARSHIP CRITERIA

1. The applicant currently must be enrolled or have applied with a qualified private school in Arizona and have a demonstrated financial & tuition need (TOPS will check with you or your child’s school to determine the balance at the time of the award. Also submit all documentations when applying that explains need.)
2. The applicant must have a current application process on file with TOPS (Apply once in May).
3. Income:
